

Volunteer Opportunities

Typical H2HS volunteer opportunities

Hands to Help Seniors, Inc. (H2HS), a humanitarian organization led by volunteers and people, guided by its Bylaws, Governing Board Policies and Procedures, and the Mission Statement, will provide relief to seniors that need help to remain independent in their home homes.

The following is a list of typical H2HS volunteer opportunities for your consideration:

- **Governing Board Member:** Volunteers serve on Governing Board of Directors to help establish policy and direction for the non-profit.
- **Grant Researching/Writing:** Volunteers needed to assist and work with the Fund Development Director in writing grants, etc.
- Office of Volunteers: Volunteers assist with writing volunteer job descriptions, setting up
 volunteer orientation courses, conduct volunteer screening interviews, help with volunteer
 placement, record keeping, and recognition.
- **Clerical:** Volunteers need to assemble class packets, stamp brochures, and deliver various kinds of information to the community as well as assist with bulk mailing, filing, and inventory etc.
- First Aid Team: Volunteers are needed to help staff special events throughout the year. Advanced medical training is helpful but not required. First Aid and CPR skills are necessary.
- Transportation Volunteer: Pick up and deliver seniors to appointments if they cannot drive to their Doctors or Grocery shopping.
- Speakers: Volunteer speakers need to do presentations within the community.
- **Publicity aide:** Volunteers need for computer data entry.
- Pinch-Hitter Volunteer: Volunteers available to help with unanticipated or irregular tasks as they arrive.
- Special Projects: Volunteers needed to assist with various duties for fundraising and special events.
